Park City Lodging, Inc. Sees Green

June 1, 2011, Park City, Utah. Park City Lodging, Inc. implemented a new rooms amenity program in the fall of 2010 with a goal to make their carbon footprint as small as possible, while providing their lodging guests with the best products available.

Teaming up with Xela Pack, Inc., an ecologically conscious packaging company, they created a custom designed package for the shampoo, conditioner and lotion placed in their condominiums in an environmentally friendly disposable paper box. The box is an environmental alternative to plastic bottles and provides a 92% reduction in waste after use. In addition, their guest soaps are also environmentally packaged and the bath bar features a waste reducing design.

Park City Lodging, Inc. has been participating in Rocky Mountain Power's Blue Sky Renewable Energy program for past the three years. In 2010 alone their support of 12,000 kilowatt-hours of renewable energy avoided the release of 14,620 pounds of carbon dioxide – equal to not driving a car 14,865 miles.

Most of the paper products used by Park City Lodging, Inc. are made from recycled paper including post cards, brochures and office supplies. Each week, Curbside Recycling picks up boxes, plastic, aluminum and waste paper to take to the recycling center for processing.

“Participation in these programs has been well received by our employees, guests and property owners,” said Rhonda Sideris, Founder and President of Park City Lodging, Inc. “We are continually looking for additional ways to be green”, she added.
